Range #4 Qualification Course

Sunday May 27th 10:00 am 2:30 pm

Saturday June 2nd 12:00 pm 4:00 pm

The program consists of lectures and demonstrations followed by written and practical testing, utilizing both Range #3 and Range #4. It's designed to familiarize the member with the fundamental skills and basic theory behind long range shooting. i.e.: MoA and scope click explanations, grouping theory, scope/iron sight adjustments, ammo range table use, hold over techniques, proper rifle hold (PAST) and breathing skills. If time and interest level permits, we'll touch on basic ballistics, and the effects of wind and temperature on projectiles.

The course will be conducted in two stages, with theory such as sight adjustments, hold" coaching (dry fire only), as well as written testing to be conducted on Sunday May 27th at Range #4 (clubhouse will be used in case of inclement weather). This will lead into the practical (live fire) testing to be completed on the following Saturday June 2nd, with the member being able to utilize the intervening time between weeks to practice their 100

meter groupings on Range #3. Before attempting the qualification shoot on Range #4, the member must be able to demonstrate a five shot 2" (scope) or 4" (iron sights) group on 100 meter Range #3. Following that and using the standard 200/300-meter Sharon bulls eye targets, a required score of 70 points at 200 meters and 60 points at 300 meters must be achieved to pass the course.

Members will require a good rifle with optical and/or iron sights, sufficient ammunition for practice and the practical test (100 rounds recommended). Also, please bring a lawn chair, notebook and pen, plus a spotting scope (if you have one). Course completion and a passing grade on the written and practical testing will qualify the member to use Sharon's (200 & 300 meter) Range #4 unsupervised. If you qualify using a scoped rifle, you may only shoot using a scope on Range#4, however, if you qualify with iron sights, you may shoot using both scopes and iron sights on Range #4.

Cost for the course is \$25.00/member
